




## TB90ADJ – 90MM T-BLADE STIRRUP, HEAVY DUTY, ADJUSTABLE

## Instructions:

- Unscrew the square base section, which exposes the threaded bar in full
- Footing must be adequately strong to withstand uplift wind loads depending on location of install and wind conditions all footings must adhere to relevant standards
- 3. Position base section
  - a. Concrete-in (Wet footing) no fastening required
    - i. Insert base section
    - ii. Secure to attain desired alignment
    - iii. Check concrete setting
    - iv. Replace with T-Blade section
    - v. Adjust to achieve desired height
  - b. **Bolt-On-Concrete** (Dry casting)
    - i. Affix 2 structural anchor bolts with washers M12 Size Galvanised on concrete
    - ii. Ensure bolts used are complaint to AS1720.1-2010
    - iii. Check to ensure base is secured fastened
    - iv. Replace with T-Blade Section
    - v. Adjust to achieve desired height
- 4. Insert pre-drilled timber post onto T-Blade and align with holes
- Affix with bolts and washer's compliant to AS1720.1-2010 5.
- Tightened and ensure bolts are well secured

## Please note:

- a. Hexnut is used to secure the height of the T-Blade section. Once it is secured then insert timber post to align with pre-drilled holes and secure with bolts
- b. A minimum clearance of 80mm from concrete floor to T-Blade section must be maintained in accordance to AS3660.1



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
